About charging fees:

The NHS provides most health care free of charge. However there are a number of other services for which fees can be charged. These are mainly for services not covered by the NHS, such as medical reports for insurance companies. Doctors are involved in a whole range of non-medical work, largely on the basis that they occupy a position of trust within the community, and are in the position to verify the accuracy of information. If a GP signs a certificate or completes a report, it is a professional duty that s(he) checks the accuracy of such information. This may involve examining the patient's entire medical record.

When will my form, letter, report be ready for collection?

That will depend on the type of form and what work is required. We always aim to complete work as promptly as possible. However private work such as this is not covered by the NHS. NHS work will remain the main priority of the doctor.

What about a Sick Certificate (or Med 3)?

If a patient is off work for less than seven consecutive days (inc. weekends and bank holidays) the GP does not have to provide a sick certificate. Some employers may insist I a certificate for periods less than seven days. In these instances a private certificate can be issued. There is no obligation for the doctor to issue this before seven days and a certificate cannot be back dated by a doctor, unless it is based on a previous assessment.

I only need a doctor to sign a form, why can't I get it done in my next appointment?

When a doctor signs a certificate or completes a report, it is a condition of remaining on the GMC Medical Register that they only sign what they know to be true. Therefore in order to complete even the simplest of forms, the doctor needs to check the patient's entire record. Please do not request that a doctor signs anything in your examination if it has not been previously discussed and agreed beforehand.

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
